Not surprisingly, health insurance rates have increased an average of 5.6%. Fortunately, vision and dental remain at the same rate as 2020-21.

Included in this memo are the 2021-22 summary sheets for your review, and an instruction sheet to enroll online. ALL CHANGES ARE TO BE MADE ONLINE. If you have not set up an account with CVT, please follow the instructions on the attached flyer.

Open enrollment information is due by September 1, for an effective date of October 1. Your October 31 paycheck will reflect the new rates.
