

# FERPA CONSENT FORM

**Disclosure of Information Protected by the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act by Princeton Joint Unified School District to Colusa County Health and Human Services, Glenn County Health and Human Services, Glenn County Office of Education, and other public health agencies.**
