California School Employees are Mandatory Reporters of Suspected Child Abuse

Code Section	Penal Code §11164, et seq.
What Constitutes Abuse	Sexual abuse or exploitation as listed by incident in 11165.1; neglect willful cruelty or unjustifiable punishment, any physical injury inflicted other than by accidental means.
Mandatory Reporting Required By	Health practitioners, child visitation monitors, fire fighters, animal control officers, humane society officers, district attorney, SCHOOL EMPLOYEES , film processors, clergy, social workers, day care workers, police department employees, administrators of public or private youth organizations or day camps.
Basis of Report of Abuse / Neglect	Knows or reasonably suspects or observes child abuse.
To Whom Reported	To a child protective agency (police or sheriff's department, county probation department, or county welfare department). The school district office has forms available to any employee who suspects abuse.
Penalty for Failure to Report or False Reporting	Misdemeanor; up to 6 months in jail and/or a fine of up to \$1,000.
