

### **New Tuberculosis Screening Requirements**

Per AB 1667, beginning January 1, 2015, a new hire/transfer not screened for TB in the past 60 days, OR a current employee due for the four (4) year TB screening will now be required to submit a CDPH/CTCA TB Risk Assessment Questionnaire completed by a physician, physician assistant, nurse practitioner, or registered nurse, in lieu of a TB skin test. If there are no risk factors identified, the Risk Assessment Questionnaire will be sufficient for new or continued employment. If risk factors are identified, a TB examination, including a TB skin test, will need to be conducted by a physician, surgeon, physician assistant or nurse practitioner.

However, if an employee has volunteered, worked or lived in a correctional or homeless facility, a TB skin test is required, regardless of when the last test or risk assessment was performed.
