1. CLOSED SESSION REPORT, ACTION AND VOTES TAKEN: No action taken.

VII. DISCUSSION AND OTHER INFORMATIONAL ITEMS:

1. Ownership/Responsibility for SPARK Building: Korey Williams informed the Board that Glenn County Office of Education has ownership of the dilapidated SPARK Building at Princeton Elementary School. The proposed pavement project is dependent upon the removal of this building. The Board requested that Korey Williams contact Glenn County Office of Education to discuss options of Princeton Joint Unified School District obtaining ownership of the SPARK Building to avoid any delay in possible capital improvement projects.

2. Indoor Graduation: Korey Williams presented the Board with possible graduation options for Princeton Jr./Sr. High School. The Board suggested that Princeton Joint Unified School District host indoor graduation ceremonies and requested that attendees wear masks and practice social distancing.

VIII. ACTION ITEMS:

1. Approve HVAC Contract: See 4/28/2021 packet. Korey Williams presented the Board with the Agreement for Princeton High School, Main Office Building, Main Classroom Building, Ag Shop Classroom - HVAC Replacement between Princeton Joint Unified School District and Carvalho's Heating and Air Conditioning, Inc. Korey Williams informed the Board that the disbursement of ESSER II funding requires state approval and there is a possibility of the project becoming a capital expenditure. Lance Glassgow moved to approve the HVAC Contract, Debbie Wills seconded. Approved with 4 ayes, 1 absent, 0 abstains.
2. Approve RFP for Portable Demolition: See 4/28/2021 packet. Korey Williams presented the Board with the Request for Proposal for the Demolition/Removal of SPARK Portable Building at Princeton Elementary School. Lance Glassgow moved to approve the RFP for Portable Demolition, Debbie Wills seconded. Approved with 4 ayes, 1 absent, 0 abstains.
3. Approve RFP for Paving: See 4/28/2021 packet. Korey Williams presented the Board with the Request for Proposal for the Removal and Installation of Asphalt at Princeton Elementary School and two maps detailing different pavement options. Lance Glassgow suggested that the RFP be revised to request one quote for complete asphalt installation and one quote for complete concrete installation. Lance Glassgow moved to approve an RFP for paving that requests one quote for complete asphalt installation and one quote for complete concrete installation, Troy Hansen seconded. Approved with 4 ayes, 1 absent, 0 abstains.
4. Allow COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic on Campus: See 4/28/2021 packet. Korey Williams presented the Board with material promoting COVID-19 vaccinations published by Northern Valley Indian Health. Lance Glassgow moved to not allow a COVID-19 vaccine clinic on campus, Troy Hansen seconded. Approved with 4 ayes, 1 absent, 0 abstains.
