1. Consider Resolution No. 2021-22-011: Order of Elections: See 06/28/2022 packet. Alex Hinely presented the Board with Resolution No. 2021-22-011: Order of Elections, calling for a regular biennial election of three Princeton Joint Unified School District governing board members on 11/08/2022.

**Debbie Wills moved to approve Resolution No. 2021-22-011: Order of Elections, Troy Hansen seconded. Approved with 3 ayes, 2 absent, 0 abstains.**

2. Consider 2021-22 J-13A: Requests for Allowance of Attendance Due to Emergency Conditions: See attached handout. Korey Williams presented the Board with J-13A: Requests for Allowance of Attendance Due to Emergency Conditions for the following dates:

**Debbie Wills moved to approve all 2021-22 J-13A: Requests for Allowance of Attendance Due to Emergency Conditions, Troy Hansen seconded. Approved with 3 ayes, 2 absent, 0 abstains.**

3. Consider 2021-22 Single Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA): Korey Williams informed the Board that the 2021-22 Single Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA) has not yet been completed. Incoming Superintendent/Principal, Christine McCormick, will be looking into the proper reporting requirements.

4. Consider Universal Prekindergarten Planning and Implementation Grant Plan: See attached handout. Korey Williams presented the Board with the Universal Prekindergarten Planning and Implementation Grant Program Plan for Princeton Joint Unified School District. The plan outlines the district's strategy to implement universally available TK for all four-year-old children by 2025-26 as required by California Education Code § 48000.

**Debbie Wills moved to approve the Universal Prekindergarten Planning and Implementation Grant Plan, Troy Hansen seconded. Approved with 3 ayes, 2 absent, 0 abstains.**

5. Consider 2022-23 Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP): See 06/28/2022 packet. Korey Williams presented the Board with the 2022-23 Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP), consisting of the 2022-23 LCFF Budget Overview for Parents, the Supplement to the Annual Update to the 2021-22 LCAP, and the 2022-23 Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP). Princeton Joint Unified School District's LCAP features three goals which address three key areas: conditions of learning, pupil outcomes, and engagement.

**Troy Hansen moved to approve 2022-23 Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP), Debbie Wills seconded. Approved with 3 ayes, 2 absent, 0 abstains.**

6. Consider 2022-23 Budget: See 06/28/2022 packet. Alex Hinely presented the Board with the 2022-23 Budget, consisting of the 2022-23 Budget, the 2022-23 Education Protection Account (EPA) Spending Plan, and the 2022-23 Budget Reserves for Economic Uncertainties. With a projected \$105,431.00 in deficit spending, the 2022-23 Ending Fund Balance is expected to be \$933,886.00.

**Debbie Wills moved to approve 2022-23 Budget, Troy Hansen seconded. Approved with 3 ayes, 2 absent, 0 abstains.**

7. Consider Revised District Bank Account Signature Authority: See 06/28/2022 packet. Alex Hinely presented the Board with a revised district bank account signature authority letter, requesting that the incoming Superintendent/Principal, Christine McCormick, replace outgoing Superintendent/Principal, Korey Williams, as a signer on all district bank accounts.

**Debbie Wills moved to approve Revised District Bank Account Signature Authority, Troy Hansen seconded. Approved with 3 ayes, 2 absent, 0 abstains**
