V. DISCUSSION AND OTHER INFORMATIONAL ITEMS:

1. Public Input Regarding Superintendent/Principal Search: See 03/17/2022 packet. Korey Williams informed the Board that an email address has been set up to allow the public to offer input into the hiring of the next Superintendent/Principal for Princeton Joint Unified School District. No suggestions have been received.

John McIntosh introduced himself as an educational consultant and shared that he is excited about the prospect of helping the district once again.

No public input.

2. Speaker for Butte City Bridge Groundbreaking: Korey Williams informed the Board that Caltrans has invited a Princeton Joint Unified School District Board Member to speak at the Butte City Bridge groundbreaking ceremony on 05/05/2022. Cathy Withrow volunteered to speak at the event. Victoria Reamer volunteered to accompany her.

VI. ACTION ITEMS:

1. Consider Endorsement and/or Gym Usage for AAU Basketball: See 03/17/2022 packet and attached handout. Jordan Dillard presented the Board with a request to use the Princeton Jr. /Sr. High School gymnasium, equipment, and weight room for the purpose of starting an independent

boys basketball team. Several students in the district have expressed interest in playing basketball outside of the winter sports season.

Roxy Vargas informed the Board that Princeton Elite AAU Basketball is independently insured, and the district would hold no liability.

Diane Roach indicated her support of Princeton Elite AAU Basketball, and asked the Board to consider endorsing the team.

Lance Glasgow expressed interest in endorsing Princeton Elite AAU Basketball and hosting AAU events in the future.

Korey Williams shared that the Princeton Jr./Sr. High School Athletic Director, Bryan Lex, should be consulted if the Board endorses Princeton Elite AAU Basketball. He also suggested that insurance coverage of the weight room should be verified before use and asked that the organization inform the public that the team is not sponsored by the school. There is minimal impact on the custodial staff expected and the district would be happy to share fundraisers on Princeton Joint Unified School District social media channels.

Lance Glasgow moved to endorse Princeton Elite AAU Basketball and allow for the use of the Princeton Jr./Sr. High School gymnasium, equipment, and weight room after receiving approval from Bryan Lex and ensuring that use of the weight room is covered by the AAU insurance policy, Victoria Reamer seconded. Approved with 5 ayes, 0 absent, 0 abstains.

2. Consider Van Purchase: See 03/17/2022 packet. Korey Williams presented the Board with a \$28,572.25 quote from Future Nissan of Roseville to purchase the 2020 Nissan Van that Princeton Joint Unified School District is currently leasing with ASES Frontier Transportation Grant funding. The nonrenewable lease with Nissan Finance is set to expire on 06/30/2022.

Lance Glasgow inquired about returning the 2020 Nissan Van and leasing a new vehicle. Korey Williams responded that there are very few vehicles currently available and the district would likely be without a vehicle for an extended period of time.

Victoria Reamer moved to approve the purchase of the 2020 Nissan Van for \$28,572.25, Debbie Wills seconded. Approved with 5 ayes, 0 absent, 0 abstains.

3. Consider A-G Completion Grant Plan: See attached handout. Korey Williams presented the Board with the A-G Completion Grant Plan. Princeton Joint Unified School District plans to extend after-school tutoring and credit recovery options that were set to end this year. Princeton Jr./Sr. High School also plans to collaborate with Butte College to offer dual enrollment options to get students back on track to graduate.

Debbie Wills moved to approve the A-G Completion Grant Plan, Victoria Reamer seconded. Approved with 5 ayes, 0 absent, 0 abstains.
